Somewhere in the range of 1981 and 2021, the female education rate expanded by 42.8 percent, while the male proficiency rate expanded by 28.3 percent. In contrast with male education rates, female proficiency rates expanded by 14.5 percent. 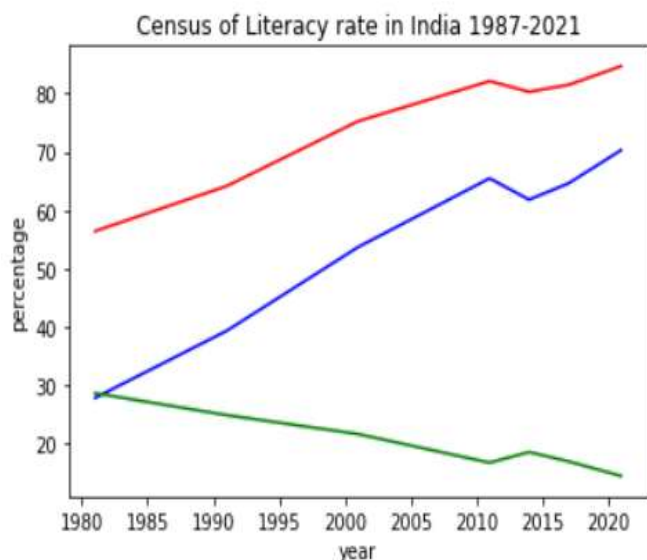


Figure 1 - Registration of Education Rate in India 1987-2021
